Why Does the Steel Industry Need Accredited Training in the Emergency Response?

- Promote Human Safety
- Reduce Operational Risk
- Reduce Reputational Risk
- Reduce Financial Risk
- Reduce Risk of going out of Business



Three **Components** to Training

- The training facility
- The instructional cadre
- The curriculums



The **Role** of the Industry

- If it introduces a risk, it **MUST** manage that risk
- It must be accountable to the communities it operates within
- It must not be satisfied with regulatory compliance alone.
- It must actively partner with local resources as much as possible
- Maintain budget for Emergency Response Training
